
FROM MONTE VISTA, CO:

HERE'S HOW IT WORKS

Turn in Bids Over the Phone. This is our traditional method of buying livestock and is the suggested process for anyone who does not have consistent, high-speed internet. To get started simply go online to www.superiorlivestock.com and click on the tab titled "Register for a Buyer Number". Select the registration form for Superior Productions and print the registration form. Fill it out and fax it in to Superior Productions at (817) 378-3380 with a signature on it. You can also mail it in to the address provided on the form. Upon receipt of this information Superior will call you with a buyer's number and the bid line phone number that you will use on sale day to place bids over the phone.

CLICK-TO-BID

This is Superior's online bidding program for cattle buying. Please note that high speed internet is required — this is not for dial-up or satellite internet. Registration is free, but you must become a member of www.superiorclicktobid.com to sign up. Becoming a member is easy — just go to the homepage of www.superiorclicktobid.com and follow the out-lined steps to get started. Input your information and select a username and password. You will receive an e-mail confirming you are a member. From that point forward you just have to sign in and select the sale you would like to register for and once approved by the ranch you will receive an e-mail confirming which sale you are now registered for.

VIEWING THE AUCTION

The sale will be broadcast via satellite on SLA-TV (DISH Network channel 997). Please note that there is a delay if you are watching the auction on television so be sure to call in a couple lots ahead of the lot you are interested in bidding on. The sale will also be broadcast live in Hi-Definition on the internet at both www.superiorlivestock.com and www. superiorclicktobid.com. The video feed on the homepage of www.superiorlivestock.com looks the same as the video feed on TV and can be watched over a smartphone or tablet. Remember you can call in to bid whether watching on the TV or on the internet, but you must be a member of www.superiorclicktobid.com to "click-to-bid".



HERD HEALTH

Cows - Ultrabac 8 and ViraShield 6 in October, rotate pour-on parasiticides in the spring + Spirovac 5 vaccine. Calf program is Vac 34. We test bulls for Trich every year and purchase only virgin bulls.

We have been running only SimAngus PAP tested bulls for the past 12 years. Bull turn out was June 19. Cows have been preg checked via ultrasound by Dr. Seth Nienhueser, and the heifers were preg checked by Dr. Greg Schick.

FIELD LAND AND GATTLE

Field Land & Cattle has roots back to the end of the Civil War. The early generations raised registered Hereford cattle. Their seedstock enterprise continued through the 1950's then evolved into primarily a commercial cow-calf business. When Tom Field graduated from Colorado State University, he returned to the ranch and introduced Angus genetics and planned crossbreeding systems. Eventually, SimAngus cattle became the standard. Our selection and breeding strategy has been built on generating heterosis via a simple crossbreeding system, disciplined focus on economically important traits with a desire to stabilize milk production and mature size in accordance with our ecosystem restraints, and a commitment to avoiding extremes. We have been relentless in culling for poor dispositions and structural defects. Cattle have been handled mostly horseback and on foot, and occasionally with four-wheelers.






